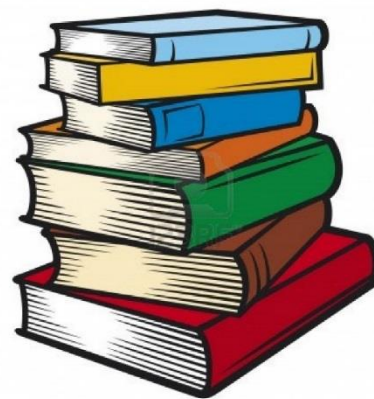

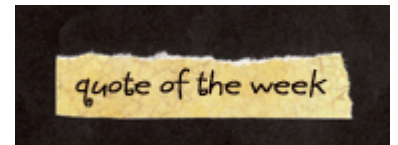
## Times Tables Rock Stars
