"He who saves a single life...saves the world"

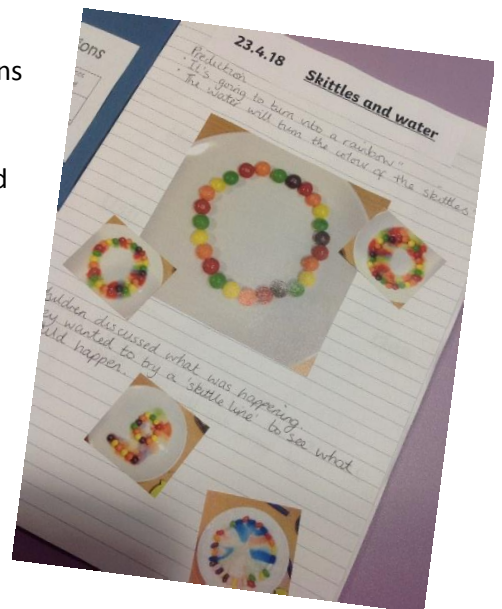




## Ten minute science

Elijah D in Class 1 has achieved his Learn to Swim Level 2 swimming award this week. Well done Elijah!

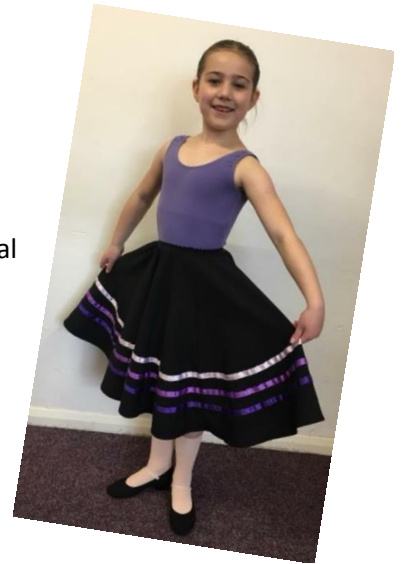

Grace and Lucy H each achieved distinctions in their recent LAMDA speaking verse and prose exams. Such a brilliant achievement girls!

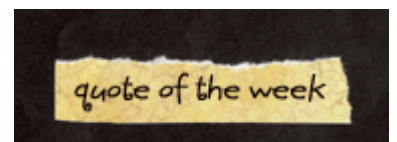
Congratulations to William P in Class 5 for having a successful season with Newark Rugby Union FC under 10's.
