## Class 5

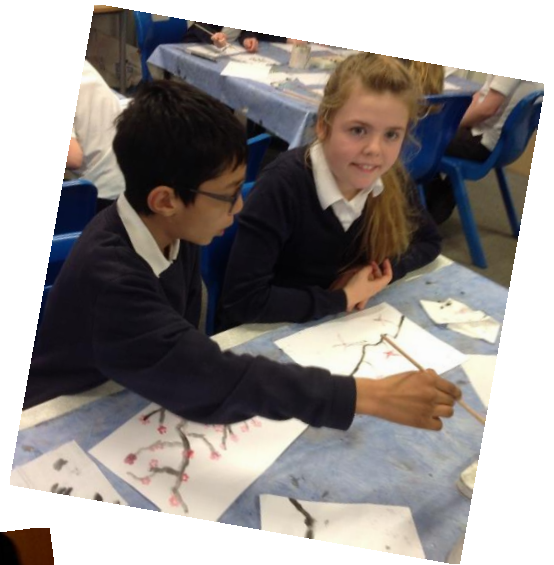

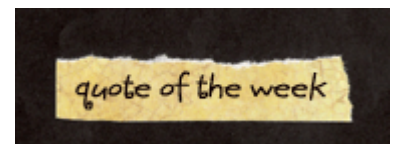
