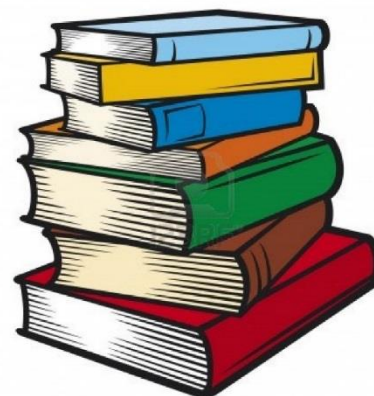

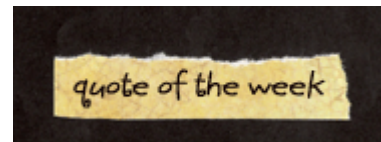




## Quote of the week
