This policy has been written using current guidance from the Department for Education on uniforms. <u>School uniforms - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk)</u>

All children attending Clarborough Primary School are asked to come to school wearing the following uniform. Sweatshirts, cardigans, polo shirts and P.E. kit with the school logo on, are available to buy from Uniform Direct in Gainsborough, or from their website, although the logos are not compulsory.

Winter Uniform

- Grey trousers, skirts or dresses,
- Navy blue sweatshirt, jumper, slip over or cardigan,
- White 'polo' type shirt, shirt or blouse,
- "Sensible" plain black shoes or boots, (no heeled shoes, boots, slip on shoes or trainers), that your child can run & play in comfortably and safely.

Summer Uniform

- Grey trousers, shorts, skirts or dresses,
- Light blue & white checked summer dresses,
- Navy blue sweatshirt, jumper, slip over or cardigan,
- White 'polo' type shirt, shirt or blouse,
- "Sensible" plain black shoes or black, brown, navy or white sandals (not slip on or trainers) that your child can run & play in comfortably and safely. Please note that either white, grey, navy or black socks <u>must</u> be worn with sandals.

Sports clothes – Year 1 to 6

- #TeamClarborough house t-shirt or plain white t-shirt and plain navy blue shorts,
- Plain navy blue hooded sweatshirt, jumper or cardigan and navy tracksuit bottoms or leggings,
- Black, navy or white training shoes or plimsolls,
- Football boots for football practice or matches only. Please note that metal studs may not be worn for any reason,
- Shin pads and long socks must always be worn for football matches/training,
- Trunks or one-piece swimming costumes should be worn for swimming. Baggy swimming shorts or bikinis are not permitted by the swimming instructors. Goggles are only allowed if a permission slip has been completed (please ask at the office).

Hair and personal appearance

- Children with long hair must have it tied up at school. Children are asked to come to school
 with a natural hair colour; dyed or bleached hair is not appropriate. We ask parents to keep
 styling products, such as gel to an absolute minimum and that any hair style is appropriate to
 the age of the child,
- Children must not wear makeup or coloured nail varnish for school. Items such as lip balm must be colourless,
- Children may not come to school with hair extensions or false/acrylic/gel nails,
- The wearing of jewellery is not permitted except for simple studs or wrist watches/items such as Fitbits. Smart watches, like Apple, Garmin, Samsung or VTech with cameras/ recording capabilities, are not to be worn.
- All items must be removed during games, swimming and other physical activities. Children who wear studs must be able to remove them by themselves. Please note that we cannot take responsibility for any jewellery and/or items such as Fitbits brought to school.

<u>General</u>

- Mobile phones and electronic devices are not allowed in classrooms or on the playground/school field. If they are brought into school they **MUST** be stored securely in the school office and collected at the end of the day,
- Children are not allowed to wear clothes that have slogans, text or pictures that could cause offence or make other children feel excluded.

Second-hand uniform is available from the school's monthly pop-up shop which takes place on the first Friday of the month.
